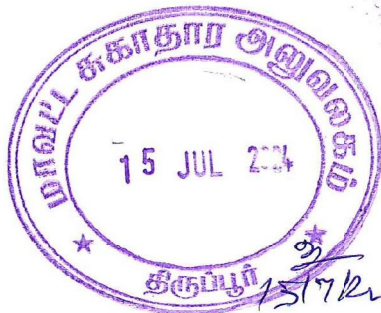
- 1) The Rooms, Halls and surroundings are maintained neat and clean.
- 2) The Sanitary arrangements provided are adequate and satisfactory.
- 3) The drinking water arrangements provided is satisfactory.
- 4) In all other necessary aspect, the sanitation is GOOD.

**This Certificate is issued subject to the following conditions:**

1. **Screening & hygiene** Provision for thermal scanning, hand wash or sanitizer will be made at all entry points and of hand wash or sanitizer at exit points and common areas.
2. **Frequent sanitization** of entire workplace, common facilities and all points which come into human contact e.g., door handles etc., will be ensured, including between shifts.
3. **Social distancing** All persons in charge of work places will ensure adequate distance between workers, adequate gaps between shifts, staggering the lunch breaks of staff, etc.
4. The Garbage generated within the Premises should be collected and disposed off properly by appointing required Sanitary Staff.
5. On any account the Garbage should not be burnt.
6. N.O.C should be obtained from the District Health office, to run a Hostel within the premises.
7. Fire precaution measures and First Aid Box should be provided.
8. Child Labour should not be engaged in any account.
9. The management should take "Preventive measures to control fly nuisance, Rat nuisance, larval breeding"
10. Every person in charge of place should be display and exhib a board stating that the place is a "No smoking and No spitting place" and that : **Smoking or spitting is an offence**"
11. This certificate issued is liable to be cancelled at any time on infringement if any of the above said conditions and for improper maintenance of sanitation, improper maintenance of the building as well as toilets in the Establishment.
12. This Sanitary Certificate **valid one year from the date of issue.**
13. The application for renewal of sanitary certificate should be submitted **30 days** before the expiry of the certificate.
